Mode of Delivery / Locations

The WSU Department of Speech and Hearing Sciences (SHS) proposes to offer a co-located (Spokane/Pullman), undergraduate program in cooperation with the Eastern Washington University (EWU) Department of Communication Disorders (COMD) on the WSU Spokane Riverpoint campus beginning Fall 2007. Speech and Hearing Sciences will continue to offer its undergraduate program in Pullman with no diminution to result from the formation of this cooperative undergraduate program in Spokane. The EWU COMD Department is moving its undergraduate program from the Cheney campus to the Riverpoint campus. The proposed cooperative undergraduate program will be the sole location of the EWU COMD undergraduate program. The cooperative undergraduate program will operate on the WSU semester-based calendar. Using the successful approach we have applied over the last 17 years in our Spokane-based cooperative EWU-WSU graduate program, each department's enrollment in the cooperative undergraduate program will be proportionate to the department's resources and other contributions to the program.
